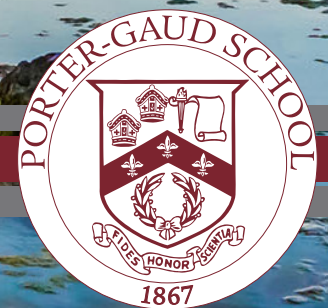

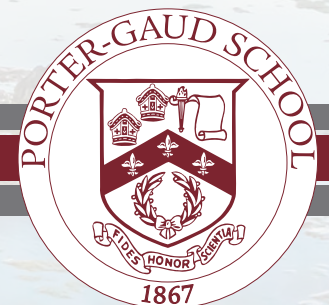

DAY 2

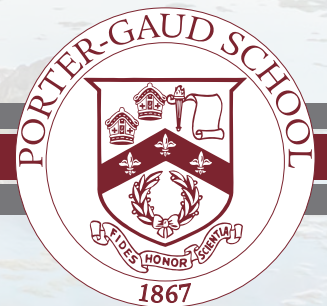
Seagrass/Mangrove Ecology, Coral Reef Ecology, Reef Fish, Zooplankton Lab.
