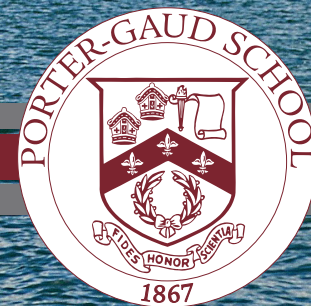

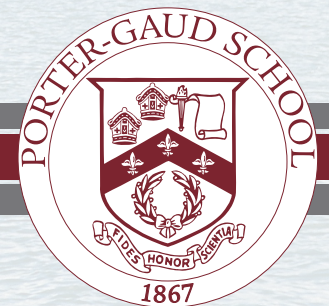

DAY 5

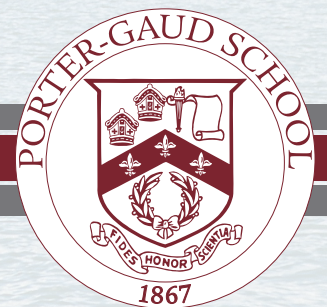
Gros-Morne: Traditional Language, Soil Work, and Dance Workshop
