

Are you interested in playing sports in college? Start by registering with the NCAA Eligibility Center as early as possible to make sure you stay on track to meet the NCAA's eligibility standards. Eligibility standards include receiving both an academic and amateurism certification. In order to receive your certifications, the Eligibility Center will request certain documents to assist in the review process through your Eligibility Center account.

To register with the <u>NCAA Eligibility Center</u>, follow these steps:

1. Create an Account:

Visit the NCAA Eligibility Center website and click on the "Register" button. You will need to provide basic information such as your name, date of birth and email address to start the registration process.

2. Complete the Registration Form:

Once you have created an account, fill out the registration form with your personal information, including your contact details, academic history and sports participation information. Provide accurate and up-to-date information.

3. Pay the Fee:

There is a registration fee you will need to pay to complete your registration. The NCAA Eligibility Center website lists current fees and payment options.

4. Contact Porter-Gaud Registrar:

A transcript will need to be submitted for each school you indicate on your school information page. Parents and students may not submit the transcript. The transcript must be sent by each school that you have attended. To have your Porter-Gaud transcript sent, contact the <u>Registrar's Office</u>.
